Lloyd Raymond Case, 87, Albany, a former Pennville resident, died Monday at his home. Born in Cotter, Ark., to William R. and Maude Case, he was preceded in death in 2009 by his wife of 62 years, Helen P. Case. He had lived in Pennville during his childhood but spent most of his life in Albany. A veteran of the United States Navy serving aboard the U.S.S. Mt. Vernon during World War II, he retired from Borg Warner after 40 years of service. Memberships include American Legion Post No. 167 in Albany, Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barbershop Quartet Singing in America, Inc., and past member of the Moose Lodge in Muncie.
