CARL GLEN MILLER, 77, of Fremont, formerly of Knox Township, Jay County, Fort Wayne and Snow Lake in Steuben County, died Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2007, at Lutheran Hospital, Fort Wayne. He was a former employee of Sears, Fort Wayne working as a service technician for 29 years. He was a farmer in Knox Township, Jay County, from 1954 to 1963. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving from 1951 to 1954. He was a former member and Past Commander of American Legion Post 31, in Angola, and a current member of American Legion Post 423, in Orland serving in the color guard and historian for the legion and a member of the 40 & 8. He served as a volunteer Marine Deputy serving on several lakes in Steuben County. He attended Fremont United Methodist Church, Fremont. Born Feb. 11, 1930, in Knox Township, Jay County, he was the son of Earl F. and Bessie (Dickson) Miller. He was raised by his father, Earl Miller and stepmother, Ruby G. Miller. He graduated from Pennville High School with the class of 1947. He married Helen Louise Flauding on June 9, 1951. Survivors include his wife of 56 years, Helen Miller of Fremont; three daughters, Sharon L. (husband, Steve) Forbes of Indianapolis, Sandra A. (husband, Mark) Radvanyi of Amherstburg, Ontario and Robin E. (husband, Virgil) Long of Accident, Md.; two brothers, Cleo F. Miller of Fort Wayne and Larry C. Hysell of Anderson; one sister, Rosa Lee Bentz of Hamilton; three granddaughters; and one great- granddaughter. He was preceded in death by one brother, Vaughn Miller; and one sister, Wanda L. Miller. Funeral service is 2 p.m. Saturday in the Pennville Chapel of Williamson & Spencer Funeral Home, with visitation two hours prior to service. Pastor Duane Stidham officiating. Visitation also from 4 to 7 p.m. Friday at Beams Funeral Home, Fremont. Burial will follow service in I.O.O.F.
