Susan Black departed this life at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. Lizzie A. Hiatt, July 6, 1900, after a protracted illness of four months, aged 78 years, 3 months and 13 days.

Susan Black was born in Kanawha County, Virginia, March 24, 1822, on April 24, 1841; she was united in marriage with William C. Black in Jackson County, Ohio. To this union were born ten children: Sarah A., Pleasant J., William S., Susan N., Mary M., James H., Joannah R. Virginia F., David L. and Lizzie A.

Pleasant J. and Mary M. with their father have preceded her to the better land.

She leaves to mourn her loss eight children and a host of friends. She united with the United Brethren Church in the year 1858, and lived a faithful member until her death. She expressed a great desire to go to her Savior.

Funeral services were conducted by Rev. Rickoff at the Mt. Zion Church. The remains were laid to rest in the Whicker Cemetery.
