

JOHN A. DEPEW

DIED AT BRYANT

**BURIAL WILL BE MADE THURS
DAY MORNING AT WHITE
OAK CHURCH**

John A. Depew died at the home of Robert Eddington, at Bryant Tuesday evening about five o'clock from the infirmities of old age, having been ill only one week. He was born in Ohio May 3, 1840 and came to Jay County in 1867. He was a veteran of the Civil war and was a member of the G. A. R. at Geneva. He was married three times, all three of his wives having died. Mr. Depew is survived by a son John Depew of Kansas and a daughter Flora, wife of Grover Butcher of Bryant. Funeral services will be held Thursday morning, at the White Oak church the funeral party leaving the house at 9 o'clock. Rev. Isaac Hollingsworth of Lynn will officiate. Burial will be made in the church cemetery.
