Richard Newton Bragg, who for the past 14 years at the inmate of the County Infirmary, died at that institution at about 4 o'clock Wednesday afternoon.

He was born in Randolph County, August 1, 1852, and was engaged at the time of death 55 years, one month and 25 days.

In his early days, the deceased followed the application of a farmer and school teacher. He was married and has one daughter, Mrs. John Hinkle, a resident of near Salamonia survives.

The remains were removed from the infirmary to the Stoltz, Williamson and Straley morgue in this city, Thursday fore noon, and prepared for burial, which took place the following day in the Zoar Cemetery, no funeral services were held.
