the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter, of the South West quarter of Section Twenty five, and the South East quarter, and the East half, of the South West quarter, of Section Twenty six, in Township Four North of Range Fourteen East, in the district of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing two hundred and eighty Acres.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *George Babcock*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *George Babcock*

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *George Babcock* and to his heirs and assigns forever.
