Know ye, that George Haley, a Private of Captain D. T. Skinner's Company "E" 119th Regiment of 7th Indiana Cavalry Volunteers, who was enrolled on the sixth day of August one thousand eight hundred and sixty three to serve three years or during war is hereby discharged from the service of the United States this 14th day of March 1865, at Indianapolis, Indiana by reason Surgeon's Certificates of disability Physically unfit to Enter or re-enlist. V.R.C.

Said George Haley was born in Fairfield in the state of Ohio, is Eighteen years of age, 5 feet 7 inches high, Light complexion, Gray eyes, Brown hair, and by occupation when enrolled, a Farmer.

Given at Indianapolis, Ind this Fourteenth day of March 1865.
