Know ye, that David Hufford, a Private of Captain James B. Doney's Company "B" Second Regiment of Heavy Artillery Ohio Volunteers, who was enrolled on the twenty third day of July one thousand eight hundred and sixty three to serve three years or during war is hereby discharged from the service of the United States this twenty third day of August 1865, at Nashville, Tennessee by reason of being mustered out in accordance With R.C. No. 3 H.D. qm. Dept. Tenn dated Aug. 7, 1865.

(\*No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist\*)

Said David Hufford was born in Warren County in the state of Ohio, is Twenty five years of age, 5 feet 5 inches high, dark complexion, Grey eyes, dark hair, and by occupation when enrolled, a Farmer.

Given at Nashville, Tenn this Twenty third day of August 1865.
