Beard, a member of the Ridgeville Town Council, died Wednesday in Veterans Administration Hospital, Dayton, following a brief illness.

Beard had lived in Ridgeville for the past three years and was elected to the town council in November.

Born Sept. 15, 1927, in Dearborn, Mich., he was the son of Harley O. and Katherine (Olsen) Beard. He had worked as a tool-and-die maker for Teddycus Tool and Die, Detroit, Mich., for 30 years. After his retirement he moved to Clearwater, Fla. and was a licensed real estate broker.

He was a veteran of the Korean War and was a member of the Church of the Nazarene, Clearwater.
