The death of Dr. J.W. Sage of Hartford City, Sunday at the age of 58 years recalls the fact that when he was in the service he was reported as having been killed. He was badly wounded at Chickamaunga. He lay all night on the battlefield. In the morning he crawled to the shade of a tree, leaving his knapsack. At roll call he did not answer roll call and a soldier who resembled him who was found dead with Dr. Sage's knapsack under his head. He was buried with the name of John W. Sage. The relatives were informed and for months mourned him. After a long stay in the hospital, he recovered and returned to his home, much to his relatives' surprise. Several years ago he visited the old battlefield and looked upon his own grave.
