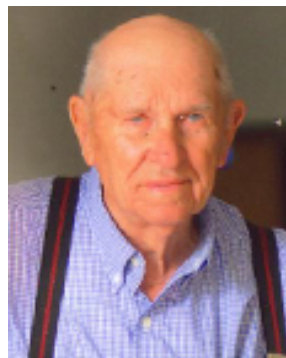


## **Jim Spade**
