I am deeply and graciously led to write you in behalf of an aged soldier of the War of Rebellion, Williamson M. Alexander, a life resident of Monroe County, Indiana, who served four years in the war, now 82 years of age, having so completely lost his eye-eight that he cannot discern one object from another, afflicted with rheumatism, having entirely lost his sense of smell, and unable to get out and enjoy that pleasing, sensational feeling of the cool atmosphere about, except as he is assisted by the steady arm of a kind friend.

Of these aged gentlemen, who have fought and died for their country, we often forget, and do not realize, that their presence upon this earth and in this our own country at the time of that great struggle, meant the peace and happiness of our lives of today. Often we are want to express and render unto them our sincere and heart-felt thanks in token of our appreciation for their valuable sacrifices made and hardship endured.

In a case of this kind, it seems, that by a careful consideration of the circumstances and a just application of the pension laws, this faithful and well-deserving old soldier might be granted a total disability pension.

As an earnest plea in his behalf, I do sincerely request that you send a pension examiner to make a thorough inquiry and investigation as to the condition of Mr. Alexander, in order that in the last years of his life he may be duly and sufficiently compensated for his faithful service to his beloved country, and that due appreciation of such service may be rendered to him.

I am certain that I express the feelings and desires of the citizens and friends of this county and community and the entire membership of the Grand Army of the Republic of Paul E. Slocomb Post of Bloomington, Indiana, in asking you to send an examiner to Bloomington in this soldier's behalf.
