FATHER OF LOCAL MAN DIES

Johnston

Chastine Johnston, 67, of Pontiac, Michigan, father of Raymen Johnston, of this place, died suddenly at his home in Pontiac from a heart attack. Johnston lived alone and is believed to have died some time Saturday. The funeral was held Tuesday at Pontiac. Mr. and Mrs. Johnston of Berne attended the rites.

The deceased was a native of northern Indiana but for many years had lived in Pontiac where he was employed in an automobile plant.

Surviving are the wife, Mrs. Ethel Johnston, the son, Raymen, of Berne, a daughter Mrs. Charles Mason of Philadelphia, and a sister. A son, Richard, was killed in action in Germany last March.
