SARAH ANN (WHARREN) SCHAEFFER

Sarah Ann, wife of Daniel Schaeffer, and youngest daughter of John and Susannah Wharren, was born in Dauphin county, Penn., May 14, 1825. She united with the Methodist Episcopal church at Harrisburg, Penn., in 1846, and was married February 24, 1847. With her husband she came to Fremont, this county, in the spring of 1855, where she resided until her death, which occurred August 1, 1890, at the age of 65 years, 2 months and 17 days. She was the mother of four sons and four daughters, seven of whom survive her, and were present at her funeral. She was an active member of society, a faithful wife and mother, strong in her attachment to those who obtained her confidence, and a messenger of mercy in the sick room. She has gone to her reward, bearing with her the respect of the community in which she lived for so many years.

The funeral was held Sunday, August 3, at the Methodist church in Fremont.
