

Death of Andrew Zimmerman.

Andrew Zimmerman passed away Tuesday night at 10:20 o'clock at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Agnes Howland, in this city, aged 62. He has been ill for some time and death was due to general debility.

Mr. Zimmerman was born in Blumberg, Germany, Nov. 6, 1842, and came to Mishawaka in 1885. He leaves a wife, two daughters, Mrs. Agnes Howland, of Mishawaka, and Mrs. F. K. Treadway, of East Lime, Conn., one brother, Peter Zimmerman, and one sister, Mrs. Joseph Bickel, of this city.

The funeral was held Thursday morning at 9 o'clock from St. Joseph's Catholic church, the Rev. L. A. Moench, officiating. Interment in the Catholic cemetery.

Death of Mr. Zimmermann.

Andrew Zimmermann, brother to Peter Zimmerman, a well-known citizen, passed away at 10:30 o'clock Tuesday night at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Agnes Howland, on Taylor street, aged over 63 years. Death was due to general debility resulting from a sun-stroke the deceased sustained some years ago, and since which time he has been in poor health. Mr. Zimmermann was born in Baden, Germany, Nov. 6, 1842, and was married in 1868. In 1885 they came to Mishawaka, but lately moved to Aurora, Ill. In February, 1902, he returned to this city. Surviving him are the wife; two daughters, Mrs. Howland, of Mishawaka, and Mrs. E. K. Treadway, of Connecticut; also the brother above mentioned and one sister, Mrs. Joseph Bickel, sr.

Funeral was held from St. Joseph's church at 9 o'clock Thursday morning, Rev. L. A. Moench officiating. Burial in the Catholic cemetery.
