

AGED RESIDENT DIES.

Peter Zimmerman, 81 Years Old, Passes F
Away Tuesday Evening.

Peter Zimmerman, aged 81, passed away at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Thomas Berner, Miami road, Center township, Tuesday evening at 5:15 o'clock after a three months illness with complications.

He was born in Baden, Germany, 1839 and was a cabinet maker by trade. Mr. Zimmerman had lived in Mishawaka since 1872 and was a member of the St. Joseph's society of the St. Joseph's Catholic church of this city. He was united in marriage 45 years ago to Miss Barbara Hannwager, who died 38 years ago.
