

SPIRITUALIST PASTOR IS DEAD

The Rev. Henry Brindle Succumbs to
Disease.

The Rev. Henry Brindle, of the local Spiritualist church, died at his home, 1344 Heustis avenue, at 12:10 o'clock Sunday afternoon, aged fifty-four years, eleven months and sixteen days. Death was due to hardening of the arteries. The Rev. Brindle was born in Fairfield county, Ohio, September 6, 1854, and came to Fort Wayne nineteen years ago. He was ordained as pastor of the Fort Wayne Spiritualist church six months ago.

Surviving are the widow, one daughter—Mrs. Mary Peck, of Indianapolis—one grandson—Harold Peck—and two brothers—William and Daniel Brindle, of Allen county. Funeral services will be conducted from the residence Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, the Rev. D. D. Dunigan officiating; burial at Ossian.
